Guidelines for the Portuguese Historical Center's "Miss Cabrillo Festival Scholarship"

The Miss Cabrillo Festival Scholarship Fund was created for/by the committee of the Miss Cabrillo Festival Pageant. Since the dissolution of the Miss Cabrillo Pageant, the committee, wanted the balance of the fund to be given to a young woman of Portuguese descent who would have been eligible to apply and who shows dedication to our Portuguese Community by her involvement. This scholarship gives her the opportunity to develop professionally, civically and socially within the San Diego Portuguese community.

In order to apply for this scholarship, candidate must:

- Be a resident of San Diego County
- Be a female of Portuguese descent
- Be a full-time high school student
- Have a grade point average of 3.0 or better (on a 4.0 scale)
- Have verifiable volunteer experience within the past two years within the San Diego Portuguese community
- Complete an application and include a one-page essay explaining how you envision your involvement in the Portuguese community after graduation

Portuguese Historical Center Scholarship Committee will select the scholarship winner, the Miss Cabrillo Festival Pageant committee would like to be informed prior to awarding the scholarship of the recipient. The Committee retains the right to withhold scholarship grants in any year if no candidate is determined to be qualified.

The PHC shall notify the chosen scholarship recipient(s) of its decision.

The scholarship payment will be made after the selected student notifies the Committee about the school (s)he will be attending. All scholarship checks will be made payable to the applicant.
