Guidelines for the Portuguese Historical Center's "Miss Cabrillo Festival Scholarship"

The Miss Cabrillo Festival Scholarship Fund was created for/by the committee of the Miss Cabrillo Festival Pageant. Since the dissolution of the Miss Cabrillo Pageant, the committee, chose the balance of the fund to be given to a young woman of Portuguese descent. This woman who would have to be eligible to apply and requires showing dedication to our Portuguese Community by her involvement and service. This scholarship gives the applicant the opportunity to develop professionally, civically, and socially for her future with hopes of continuing her service with the San Diego Portuguese Community

To apply for this scholarship, candidate must:

- Be a resident of San Diego County
- Be Female and of Portuguese descent
- Be a full-time high school student
- Have a high school grade point average of 3.0 or better (on a 4.0 scale)
- Have verifiable volunteer experience within the past two years within the San Diego Portuguese community
- Complete an application and include a one-page essay explaining how you envision your involvement in the Portuguese community after graduation

Portuguese Historical Center Scholarship Committee will select the scholarship winner. The Committee retains the right to withhold scholarship grants in any year if no candidate is determined to be qualified.

The PHC shall notify the chosen scholarship recipient(s) of its decision.

The scholarship payment will be made after the selected student notifies the Committee about the school (s)he will be attending. All scholarship checks will be made payable to the applicant.
